

Personal data policy (customers)

GDPR stands for General Data Protection Regulation and this is a new EU regulation aiming at strengthening your personal integrity as a substitute for the Personal Data Protection Act.

For you as a customer, this change will not lead to any alterations in terms of services or prices.

At Stjernholm A/S, we want you to continue to feel safe with regards to us processing your data.

We process your data for the purpose of delivering our products and services to you. Or as support in relation to a purchase. Or to fulfil a contract or a purchase agreement. And we might have to process your data in order to fulfil a legal requirement, e.g. in connection with the bookkeeping law.

And in order to offer you, as a customer, effective and good customer service.

The primary data about you that we use include, amongst others: name, telephone number, payment information and e-mail address. If you are an industrial customer, we do not process any other personal data.

If you are a private customer, however, we process the above-mentioned information as well as your private address and telephone number.

We collect information from the following sources:

- directly from you
- from publicly available sources such as telephone registers, Proff and other websites.
