

Personal Data Policy (customers)

GDPR is short for General Data Protection Regulation and is a new EU regulation aiming at strengthening your personal integrity. It will replace the Danish Data Protection Act.

To you, the customer, there will be no changes in our services or prices.

However, if you are a private customer, we will also process your private address and postal code in addition to the above.

We collect data from the following sources:

- Directly from you
- From publicly available sources, e.g. phone registers, Proff and other websites.
